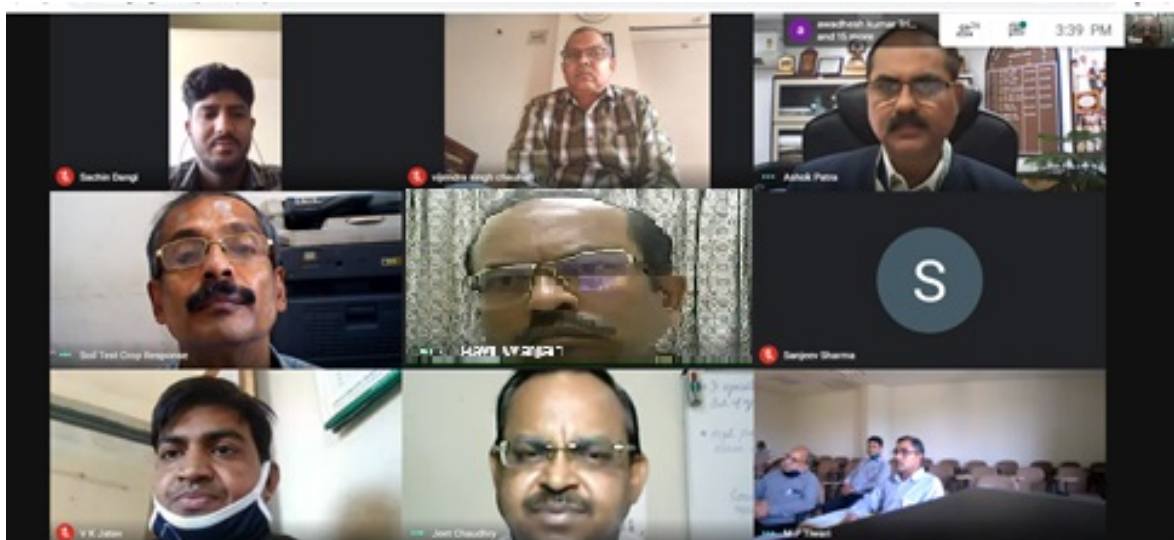


Online Training on 'Soil Health Management'
